

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q: Who can participate in the 'Round The Frame' short film competition?

A: The competition is open to filmmakers worldwide who are 18 years of age or older. Minors may participate with parental or legal guardian consent.

Q: Can I submit more than one film?

A: Yes, each participant or team may submit multiple entries to the competition, provided each film meets the submission guidelines and themes.

Q: What are the themes for the competition?

A: The themes for the 'Round The Frame' competition are "Echoes of Connection," "Family Constellations," "Soul's Odyssey," "Cultural Kaleidoscope," and "Journey To Wholeness." Your film must adhere to one of these themes.

Q: What is the maximum duration for submitted films?

A: The maximum duration for each film, including credits, should not exceed 30 minutes.



Q: How should I submit my film?

A: Films must be submitted online through the official 'Round The Frame' submission portal. Detailed instructions will be provided on the portal. [Portal Link]

Q: Are English subtitles required if my film is in a language other than English?

A: Yes, all films must include English subtitles, regardless of the language of the film.

Q: What rights do I retain over my film after submitting it to the competition?

A: Participants retain all rights to their films and are free to showcase their work independently after the competition. By submitting a film, participants grant Reborn India Film the right to screen the film during the 'Round The Frame' event, related promotional activities, showcase on social media platforms (including but not limited to YouTube), and inclusion in their film festival.

Q: How will films be judged?

A: Films will be evaluated based on technical aspects including writing, cinematography, production design, editing, and direction. Additionally, adherence to the chosen theme and overall impact will be considered. A panel of judges appointed by Reborn India Film will conduct the evaluation.



Q: Can I make changes to my submission after it has been submitted?

A: No, once a film has been submitted, changes cannot be made. Please ensure your submission is final and meets all requirements before completing the submission process.

Q: How can I attend the awards night or screening events?

A: Details about the awards night and screening events will be provided closer to the event date. Participants and interested parties can stay updated through our official communication channels and website.

Q: Will I receive feedback on my submission?

A: While we aim to provide feedback, due to the volume of entries, detailed feedback may not be possible for all submissions. However, all participants will receive notifications regarding the status of their entries.

Q: What are the criteria for disqualification from the competition?

A: Films may be disqualified if they do not adhere to the competition rules, infringe upon copyright or intellectual property rights, contain inappropriate content as determined by the organizers, or fail to stick to the assigned theme.



Q: When and how will winners be announced?

A: Winners will be announced during the awards night at 'Round The Frame.' Details regarding the awards ceremony and notifications will be communicated to all participants.

A: Yes, there is an early bird entry fee of INR 500 to participate in the event. After the early bird period, the fee will be adjusted as per the festival requirements.
